## ABOUT MISSION 44

Established by Sir Lewis Hamilton in 2021, Mission 44 is a charitable foundation working to ensure that every young person can thrive in school and access great careers in STEM. We invest in bold organisations, leaders and ideas, connect leaders to share learning and campaign for change. In building a fairer future for young people, we pursue three goals:

- An inclusive education system in which young people are supported to succeed,
- Opportunities to pursue great careers in STEM and motorsport,
- Opportunities to take action and shape the world they live in.

Since launching in 2021, Mission 44 has supported 43 organisations across the UK, US, and Brazil, invested £8 million to improve young people's lives, and reached more than 550,000 young people through our programmes and partnerships.

As a youth-focused foundation, we view young people as active collaborators in creating an inclusive future. Aligned with our values, we collaborate with young people to drive change and remain inclusive by amplifying their voices in all we do. Our commitment is to share power, to ensure they have meaningful influence over the decisions that affect their lives. After three years of impactful collaboration, the term of our inaugural [Youth Advisory](#) cohort will end in April 2026. To continue this work, we are recruiting a new group of 12 Advisors to join Mission 44 for the next three years.

## ABOUT THE ROLE

As a Youth Advisor, you'll make sure young people's voices are at the heart of what we do. You'll share ideas, challenge thinking, and bring fresh perspectives that help us create real, meaningful change. You'll contribute across several key areas of our work:

<b>Strategy, evaluation, Impact</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Contribute to organisational and programme strategy, evaluating impact, and identifying opportunities to improve outcomes for young people.</li></ul>
<b>Amplifying Storytelling</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Champion authentic stories to highlight lived experiences and drive change.</li></ul>
<b>Convening, advocacy and campaigning</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Engage in initiatives that bring young people together and amplify their voices.</li><li>Support campaigns that advocate for social justice and ensure young people are heard at a policy level.</li></ul>
<b>Innovation Programmes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Collaborate with Mission 44 to ensure young people are influencing decision-making in the philanthropy sector.</li></ul>
<b>Grantmaking</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Contribute to grant management activities, such as partner visits.</li></ul>
<b>Governance and Operations</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Inform grant decisions via our <a href="#">Impact Committee</a><sup>1</sup>, represent Youth Advisors at Trustee Board meetings and staff away days.</li><li>Support staff recruitment and commissioning processes.</li></ul>

## WHO ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

We're especially keen to hear from young people who don't usually get the chance to be involved in Youth Advisory roles or the grantmaking world. Our goal is to build a group that reflects the real diversity of young people across the UK. So whatever your background, ability, or life experience, you can apply. What matters most is your perspective and your passion for making change. And if this is your first time applying for something like this, that's totally okay (actually, it's a big plus!).

We are interested in your ideas, your commitment to social change, intergenerational collaboration<sup>3</sup> and openness to learning. We're looking for individuals who bring lived or learned experiences and care about making a difference for young people in our impact areas, including Inclusive Education, STEM, and Motorsports. We also want to hear from individuals with interests in our work areas, such as grantmaking and fundraising, convening, campaigning, and storytelling.

To be eligible to apply, you must:

- Be aged 16–25 and based in the United Kingdom.
- Be passionate about social change and supporting young people to thrive and succeed.
- Show how you align with our mission, core values and how you champion inclusion.

- Be committed to sharing your experiences, insights, and ideas to influence positive change.
- Have a strong interest in one or more of the impact or work areas listed above.
- Hold good communication and listening skills.
- Be willing to bring new ideas and perspectives to our work.
- Be able to work with others from a range of backgrounds.
- Be able to dedicate the necessary time to the role.
- Be willing to commit to ongoing personal and professional learning and development.

We're prioritising young people who are often underrepresented in Youth Advisory roles, including those who are D/deaf, disabled or neurodivergent; from communities experiencing social inequality; LGBT+; or who have migration or care experience.

## WHAT'S EXPECTED OF YOU?

There are lots of different activities for all Youth Advisors to engage in at Mission 44. We hold monthly touchpoints, usually scheduled in advance, to stay connected and ensure your voice helps shape what we do. We'll support you to get involved in ways that fit your time and interests, so your voice really makes an impact. We also understand that capacity and interests vary, so we can support you to fit this around schedules.

### Core commitments include:

- Attend and actively engage in core meetings every two to three months (approximately 2-4 hours per month)
- Fully participate in assigned work areas, activities and any additional opportunities you opt into.
- Engage in regular reflection and learning sessions to help improve our practice.
- Attend and actively engage in scheduled training and development sessions.
- Join in-person quarterly away days for deeper collaboration, connection and planning.
- Work collaboratively with other Advisors and staff members, sharing insights and ideas to shape and influence.
- Investing in your own personal and professional development to ensure you're getting the most from the opportunity as an Advisor

Most activities will take place online. Throughout the year, we'll invite you to join in-person sessions at our London office for key events such as workshops and planning meetings. We'll cover travel costs and expenses, and provide support to make these sessions accessible for you. For more details on accessibility and support in your role, please refer to our [FAQs](#).
